What Is Sin?

- 10 Commandments
- Any action or thought God defines as sin
 - Something we do
 - God's commands we fail to do:
 - Love your spouse
 - Honor your parents

Why Does God Care About Sin?

- · Sin hurts you & others God loves
- Robs us of blessings on earth and in heaven
- Sin gives Satan access to us: Eph. 4:26-27
- · Sin forces God to discipline us in love
- Sin is the **greatest threat** to humanity in this life and the next.

How Serious is Sin to God?

- ·Sin brings death.
 - God almost wiped out Israel due to its sins
 - God demands eternal punishment for sins
 - · God often warns Christians about sin
 - God sacrificed His own Son to pay for sin
 - Only born-again Christians can enter heaven

What Motivates Us To Sin?

- •Our broken sinful nature we inherited
- Our daily choice to not love God with all our heart, soul, strength and mind.
 - That sin makes all other sins easier to do
- We use sin as a solution to a real need
- Once we sin, that sin leads us to sin more

The Best Defense Is a Good Offense

- The more we enjoy God, the less we enjoy sin
- Full surrender to God weakens temptations
- · Being full of the Spirit leaves less room for sin
 - Iwakuni, Japan story
- Sin comes from a love deficit: The less we love God, the more we sin

How to Kill the Lies That Lead Us to Sin

- Everyone believes some lies about themselves
- Lies can create emotional and physical pain.
- · Lie-based pain drives us to seek a solution.
- · Sin is often the solution to lie-based pain
- God wants to replace those lies with His truth
- · His truth sets you free from needing that sin

How to Kill the Lies We Believe About Ourselves

- TPM, Sozo and Emmanuel Prayer can help!

- Unforgiveness will hinder your ability to sense the Lord communicating with you.

Episode Two: Revisited

- God often warns Christians about sin. Why?

- Sin can limit God's blessings: 1 Cor. 3
 - The prodigal son lost his inheritance
- Sin can lead to God's discipline: Heb 12
 - •1 Cor. 5: Turned over to Satan for Incest
- Sin can cause you to lose your salvation!

- Words are not enough: Matthew 7:21
- Cut off limbs rather than sin: Mk. 9:43ff
- Must endure to end to be saved: Matt. 24:13
- If you fall away—can't come back: Heb 6
- Name erased from Book of Life: Rev. 3:5
- Unrepentant, persistent sin can **disqualify you** from heaven: Gal. 5: 19-21

- "Sexual immorality, impurity and debauchery; idolatry and witchcraft; hatred, discord, jealousy, fits of rage, selfish ambition, dissensions, factions and envy; drunkenness, orgies, and the like.
- I warn you, as I did before, that those who live like this will not inherit the kingdom of God.

What is Repentance?

- **Metanoia:** Meta & noeo = change your mind—> change of actions, values, character, lifestyle, friends and goals.
- First words of Jesus! "Repent for the Kingdom of God is at hand."
- Agree with God's Word in your thoughts!
 - Commit to **do** what he commands and **stop doing** what He forbids
 - When you sin, confess them, but also promise God to not do that again and show that with actions!

Examples of Repentance

- Choose to forgive specific people from your blame.
- · Stop looking at non-spouses with sexual thoughts
- Plan to report all your income to the IRS
- Apologize for gossiping to those who heard it
- Be good to someone you have wronged (Zacchaeus)
- Choose holiness over happiness in every decision

How Important is Repentance to God?

- God sees repentance as love for Him: John 14:21
- God sent His only begotten Son to die a horrible, excruciating death so He would not have to send us to hell *forever* for our sins.
- Therefore, God sees our unrepentance as a deep, personal offense against Him.

How To Repent Well?

- Have a written plan to OBEY GOD'S COMMANDS
- · Check yourself daily against that plan
- · Ask others to hold you accountable
- Update the plan AS NEEDED
- Ask for prayer, get wise counsel and always compare your goals to the Bible, not culture.

- •What is sex for?
 - Multiply and raise many children for heaven!
 - Only between a male husband and female wife
 - · Builds intimate marriage love -
 - Prepares us for the intimate love of Jesus and His Bride
 - A test to prepare us to reign with Jesus (talents)

Power of sex

- "For love (sex?) is strong as death" Song: 8:6
- Major sin pattern in every age, OT & NT
 - Judah, **David**, many Christians, pastors, priests, bishops, presidents and doctors
 - The American Church is full of sexual sin today: Porn & fornication & sexual abuse

•Specific sins:

- Fornication (Lustful thoughts)
- Adultery (Lustful thoughts)
- Incest (1 Cor. 5)
- Beastiality
- Masturbation
- Homosexuality (Rom. 18-32) (6 Denominations)

•Sexual sins are serious sins:

- "Flee sexual immorality. Every other sin that a person commits is outside the body, but the sexually immoral person sins against his own body." I Cor. 6:18
- •God, the Holy Spirit lives in your body!

- Sexual sins are serious sins:
 - Emotional damage
 - Sexual diseases
 - Legal penalties
 - · Spiritual bondage, demonization
 - Promotes aborting babies
 - · Can be spiritually fatal for the unrepentant

• Sexual sins are serious sins:

- You become one with the person you have sex with. 1 Cor. 6:16
 - Their demons can enter you and yours can enter into them.
 - "Soul ties" are created. You are chained to them.

- Sexual sins are serious sins:
 - In the OT, death was the penalty for adultery, incest and raping an engaged woman and homosexual sexual acts
 - God penalizes rebellios people by giving them over to **homosexuality** (Rom. 1:26-27)
 - Unrepentant sexual sins can send anyone—even Christians—to hell forever.

1 These. 4: 3-8

It is God's will that you should be sanctified: that you should **avoid** sexual immorality;

that each of you should learn to **control your own body** in a way that is **holy and honorable**, not in **passionate lust** like the pagans, who do not know God;

and that in this matter no one should wrong or take advantage of a brother or sister. The Lord will punish all those who commit such sins, as we told you and warned you before.

For God did not call us to be impure, but to live a holy life.

- How to stop sinning sexually
 - Sexual sin is a solution to a real need
 - · Loneliness, rejection, shame, fear, guilt
 - Ask God for **His truth** to heal your damaged emotions. Also, **deliverance**!
 - The more you enjoy God, the less you sin
 - · Become accountable to someone
